Directions:

From Wilton: Take Route 31 through Lyndeboro. Watch for the Yankee Farmer Nursery on the left. Turn immediately left onto Russell Station Road. Watch for a stop sign. Turn right onto Mountain Road and go up a hill. The sign for Plowshare Farm will be on the left. Turn left and Agora is the stately green building on the left with the pond, flow form, and parking in front of it.

From Peterborough: Go north on Route 202 about 1.5 miles from its intersection with Route 101. Turn right on Sandhill Road and continue for about 4.5 miles. The sign for Plowshare Farm will be on the right. Turn right and Agora is the stately green building on the left with the pond, flow form, and parking in front of it.

The lay services take place in the chapel at High Mowing School, 335 Abbot Hill Road, Wilton NH, 03086

Directions:

From the east of Wilton: Take Route 101 west to Wilton. Watch for signs to the Pine Hill Waldorf Auditorium, Abbot Hill Road, and High Mowing School. Turn left onto Abbot Hill Road. High Mowing is on the right, at the top of the hill, in 1.5 miles. Turn right and take the first driveway to the left. Follow this to the fields and park. The chapel is a small building on the right attached to the main building by a breezeway. It has diamond-paned leaded glass windows.

From the west of Wilton: Take Route 101 east to Wilton. Watch for signs to the Pine Hill Waldorf Auditorium, Abbot Hill Road, and High Mowing School. Turn right onto Abbot Hill Road. Follow the rest of the instructions listed above.
