A short description of the daily events of the founding will follow the service.

In September 1922, a group of 45 people devoted to the idea of the renewal of religious life in the spirit of Anthroposophy met with Rudolf Steiner at the First Goetheanum. During those days, The Christian Community – Movement for Religious Renewal was inaugurated out of the spiritual world. Between September 12 – 16, as the renewed Christian sacrament was gradually incarnating in its new “body”, the first Ordination of Priests took place. On September 16, 1922, Rev. Friedrich Rittelmeyer celebrated the first Act of Consecration of Man. Since that time, the Renewed Sacraments are celebrated in the congregations of The Christian Community worldwide. We will celebrate these significant events between September 11 – 16. However, rather than celebrating the past, this week is intended as a **festive inauguration** of the beginning of the second century of The Christian Community – the church of the Etheric Reappearance of Christ.
